



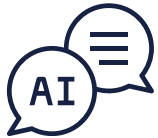

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KNOWTEX AI SCRIBE – FAQ's

What is Knowtex?

Knowtex Artificial Intelligence (AI) scribe is a secure, voice-enable technology that creates a draft of the medical note so your provider can focus more on you and less on the computer.

Is our conversation being recorded?

Knowtex AI scribe actively helps in generating a written summary of your visit in real time but does not store or save audio recordings.

Is my information safe and private?

Yes. Knowtex AI is designed to be HIPAA compliant and secure, meaning your health information is protected with the same level of security as all other medical records.

Can I opt out of having Knowtex AI used during my visit?

Absolutely. Your comfort is our priority. If you prefer not to have AI scribe used during your visit, just let us know.

Will the AI make the medical decisions?

No. Knowtex AI only helps with documentation. Your provider still makes all the medical decisions and reviews every note before it becomes part of your record.

Can I have a copy of the note it creates?

Yes. You can request to review your visit notes through your patient portal or by asking our staff for a copy of your record?
